**Dear Leaders Thune and Schumer,**

The undersigned companies and organizations urge you to schedule the Clarity Act for consideration by the full United States Senate.

The Senate Banking Committee's bipartisan passage of the Clarity Act marks a defining moment for American leadership in digital finance. It reflects months of serious, bipartisan work and recognition across party lines that the United States needs clear rules of the road for digital asset markets. The Senate should now build on that momentum and give members the opportunity to advance durable market structure legislation.

Digital asset markets are global, growing, and central to the future of financial infrastructure. The question before Congress is whether that future will be built in the United States — under U.S. law, U.S. oversight, and American values — or continue moving to offshore jurisdictions with less transparency, weaker consumer protections, and limited accountability. The Clarity Act gives Congress the opportunity to keep innovation, jobs, investment, and market activity here at home while strengthening America's role as the global leader in digital asset innovation.

This bill is about ensuring both innovation and consumer protection. The Clarity Act would establish a comprehensive federal framework for digital asset markets, clarify regulatory responsibilities, create workable registration pathways, maintain protections for software developers, and bring more digital asset activity into responsible U.S. markets. Clear oversight will strengthen market integrity, improve transparency and accountability, and give consumers greater confidence when engaging with digital asset products and services.


Durable policy must be built across party lines, especially when it will shape the future of American financial markets. The Clarity Act reflects years of education, stakeholder engagement, and good-faith policymaking. The result is a serious and balanced framework that advances consumer protection, market integrity, responsible innovation, and U.S. competitiveness.

The United States has the deepest capital markets, the strongest rule-of-law tradition, world-class entrepreneurs, and a long history of leading in financial innovation. Congress should bring those strengths to digital assets. With the Clarity Act, the Senate has a chance to ensure the next generation of financial infrastructure is built, governed, and regulated in America.

We respectfully urge you to bring the Clarity Act to the Senate floor without delay.





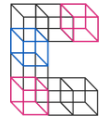
